WORKSHOP: Autism Intervener Certificate 4 days Training Program Level 1
27 – 28 February, 26 – 27 March from 8:30am to 4:30pm

Description: Participants will gain a thorough understanding of Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD) and an overview of current intervention techniques. Content will include diagnostic characteristics, current theories regarding causation, communication challenges, sensory and behavioural considerations, anxiety and ASD, social skill difficulties and Asperger's Syndrome. Intervention strategies for all areas will be reviewed.

Participants will be required to write a brief evaluation. There will be written assignments throughout the course that draw on current or recent experience with an individual with an ASD. Contingent upon regular attendance, successful completion of the assignments and

achieving at least 80% on the evaluation, participants will receive a certificate indicating that they received Level 1 training from the Geneva Centre for Autism. This course is designed for people who are currently supporting an individual with an ASD and will be limited to 20 participants.
