As a think and do organization, UNA-Canada supports a network of 17 volunteer branches and local contacts, with a National office in Ottawa and a Western professional office in Vancouver. Our mandate is to engage Canadians in the work of the UN and the critical global issues that affect us all through innovative projects, policy research, and on-going communications with Canadians.

Eligibility

- Open to all photographers of all ages.
- Entries must originate from within Canada.
- Each photograph is a single entry.
- There is no limit to the number of entries per person but each submission must include a separate entry form (or a reproduction of facsimile.)
- Photos containing identifiable people must also be accompanied by a model release form. Model releases are the responsibility of the entrant and must be available in the event the photo is a winner. Numerous entries do not need to be mailed in separate envelopes.
- To be considered in the contest, all submissions must be original, unpublished photographs

Fees

There is no fee to enter.

Submission of entries acknowledges the right to use them for publication and exhibition. By signing the entry form, the contestant grants UNA-Canada the unrestricted and exclusive rights to use photograph(s) for any purpose. This includes, but is not limited to, publishing your photograph(s) in print or electronic form for promotional purposes without compensation, and the right to use the photographers name as a credit along with the photograph. The photographer must own all rights to any photographs entered in this contest.
